CAMP SCHEDULES

To learn what the camp schedule is at your student's location this summer visit the fuge.com website and click on the appropriate camp program. A tentative Fuge Camp Schedule is included in this pack.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Linens; 2 towels, pillow, sleeping bag or sheets & blanket
- Card games (such as Rook, Skip-Bo, Phase10, Uno, or playing cards) No electronic games!!!
- Water bottle that you can refill and carry with you
- 2 pair closed toe, closed heel shoes (for outdoor activities, in case one gets wet) and flip-flops or sandals for lounging
- A GOOD attitude, no complaining
- Bible, notepad, and pen
- Toiletries such as soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush & toothpaste
- Sun protection
- Snacks (chips, candy, etc)
- Spending money for snacks, Fuge store, and **missions offering** (optional)

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP

- **DO NOT BRING** alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, fireworks, water guns, or any kind of weapon
- **DO NOT BRING** radios, iPods, CD players, laptops, roller blades, skateboards
- **NO CELL PHONES...** (Fuge allows cell phones, but Pastor Matt does not) parents may call leaders to contact their student. See FBC-Leader Contact List, for a list of leader cell numbers. Any cell phones brought on the trip by students will be collected by the leader and given back to the student once we have returned to the church. FBC Kissimmee is **NOT** responsible for any lost or stolen phone.
- **NO DVD players!**

DRESS CODE

Please ask your students not to pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations
- Has spaghetti straps, except for sleepwear
- Is excessively short or tight fitting

While at camp, we ask that students and adults:

- Wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two piece suits covered with a DARK colored T-shirt.
- Wear modest shorts, dresses, slacks, and jeans for worship. Long pants or knee-length skirts are required for students or adults participating in worship on stage.
- Do not dress in a way that calls attention to their underwear (sagging pants, rolling down waistbands, etc)
- A dark t-shirt if student plans to take the messy games or water games track.

DISCIPLINARY PROBLEMS

Please know, in advance, that if there is a serious disciplinary problem you will be asked to pick your student up or your student will be sent home at your expense. Pastor Matt will be the judge of whether the disciplinary problem constitutes your student being sent home. There will be many students at camp and there is not time for a leader to give all his/her attention to one student.

NIGHT LIFE

Night Life at Fuge camps is a time for the whole camp to come together and get a little crazy. Each night has a different fellowship activity.

One Night Life will be called “The Big Game Hunt” where students will partake in an activity much like a safari. This will be a “dress up” Night Life so come with safari attire and get ready for fun.

Another Night Life is the “Track Time Showcase” (Centrifuge and Combo Camps only). This will be a time where students who signed up for performance track times such as creative movement, drama, percussion etc. can perform on stage for everyone.

Mega Relay is another annual Fuge tradition. This Night Life is a camp-wide relay competition for students and adults.

THE FUGE STORE

The Fuge store is available at camp for students to purchase camp apparel, CDs, bags and much more. After April 1, check the fuge.com website to see what items will be available in the Fuge store this summer. No pre-orders can be taken before the summer.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Fuge takes the special needs of students and adults seriously. Meeting your needs and setting up your group for a great week of camp is important to FUGE.

If one of your students has a special need that should be handled before camp starts, please allow the Group Leader to call our camp toll free line (1.877.CAMP.123) and share that with FUGE events registration team. so that it can be handled properly. If your student’s need should be known by our staff at camp, you have the option of completing a “Special Attention Card” for your student so that this need can be addressed by the Fuge staff. Your Group Leader will also be able to fill out a Special Attention Card once they arrive on campus, so it is not necessary to fill this out now.

If your student damages the camp’s property, you will be responsible for paying for the repairs. You will also be asked by the facility to pay for any lost keys.
